Getting Started Guide

This guide walks you through everything from creating an account to printing your first scannable arc flash labels. Follow the steps below in order — each one unlocks the next.

1. Create Your Account

Step 1. Register

From the homepage, click “Get A Quote” or “Login” in the top menu, then choose the “Register” tab. Enter your company name, a work email address, and a password, then submit.

Step 2. Verify your email

Check your inbox for a verification email and click the link inside it. You won't be able to log in until your email is verified — this keeps the account list free of spam and abandoned signups.

2. Get Your Quote

Step 3. Request a quote

Click “Get A Quote” and tell us your approximate label count, whether you'll print your own labels or want us to print and ship them, any optional add-ons you're interested in, and any other details about your facility.

Step 4. Wait for your order

Every quote is reviewed personally so pricing fits your facility — it isn't generated automatically. You'll be notified once your order is ready to review, usually within a business day or two.

3. Review, Sign, and Pay

Step 5. Review your order

Log in and click “My Order” in the top menu. You'll see your label count, printing option, add-ons, and pricing.

Step 6. Enter your contract details

Fill in your company's legal name, entity type, state of incorporation, address, and billing/notices contacts — this information fills in your contract automatically.

Step 7. Sign your agreement

Review the full Master Subscription Agreement, auto-filled with your information and order details, then sign it electronically by typing your name and title.

Step 8. Pay

Complete payment through our secure Stripe checkout, covering your setup fee and first year of subscription. Your subscription activates immediately after payment.

4. Build and Print Your Labels

Step 9. Open the Tools tab

Go to your Dashboard and click the “Tools” tab, which unlocks once your subscription is active.

Step 10. Import your data

Under “Import Arc Flash Data,” upload an Excel file of your equipment. Each row becomes a bus/equipment record with its own QR code.

Step 11. Choose your sticker style (optional)

Under “Sticker Style,” pick which fields print directly on the label and preview it live before saving.

Step 12. Print your labels

Use “Print Company QR Codes” to generate a printable sheet of every QR code in your database. If you chose to have QR Safety Solutions print and ship, your physical labels will arrive separately.

Step 13. Print a backup binder copy

Use “Print Arc Flash Labels” to generate a full paper copy of your hazard data, kept on-site in case of an internet outage in the field.

Step 14. Install and scan

Apply the labels to your equipment. Anyone can then scan a label in the field to instantly see the latest approved arc flash data.
